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Marine Well Containment Company to Participate in 23rd Annual Clean Gulf Conference & Exhibition

Houston, TX, November 12, 2013 – Marine Well Containment Company (MWCC) will take part in North America's leading oil spill prevention and response conference and exhibition, Clean Gulf, in Tampa, Fla. November 12-14. At this year's event, four MWCC representatives will present as part of the "Prevention, Preparedness & Planning" and "Deepwater Prevention & Response" conference tracks. MWCC company executives and representatives will be available for discussion in booth 609 in the exhibit hall on Nov. 13 and 14. Booth visitors can learn more about the company and its containment capabilities, view video footage of MWCC's two shore base facilities and watch an animation showing how MWCC's [interim containment system](#) (ICS) would be mobilized to cap a well in the U.S. Gulf of Mexico.

The 23rd annual conference gathers more than 2,600 emergency responders from across the Gulf Coast to share best practices and lessons learned in response operations. Topics include the latest product offerings, services and technologies, environmental and security concerns, and the relationships between regulators, operators and response communities.
